Here are some ways to get involved: **Please bring colored pencil** packets to worship throughout the months of August!

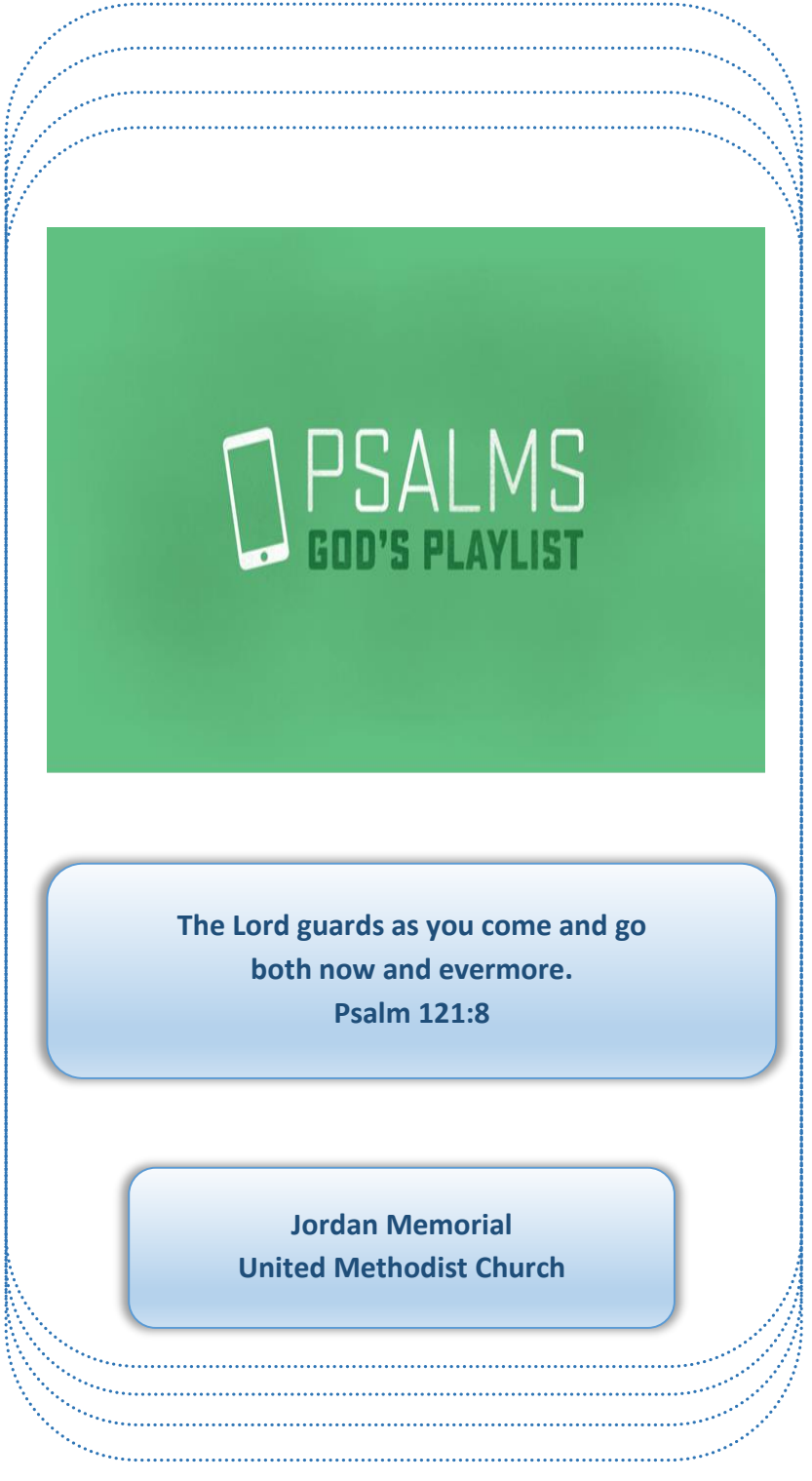
+ we need **book bag blessers and stuffers** on Friday, August 24th at 10am.
