AA Group

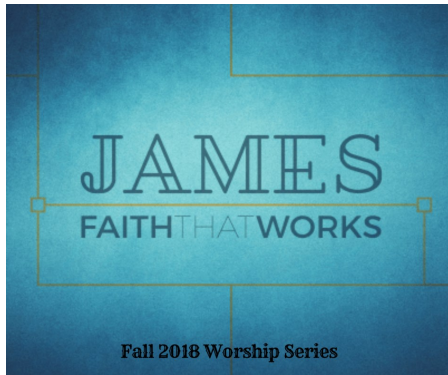

Tai Chi classes are held on Saturday mornings at 9am in the fellowship hall. October Saturday classes are October 6, 27.

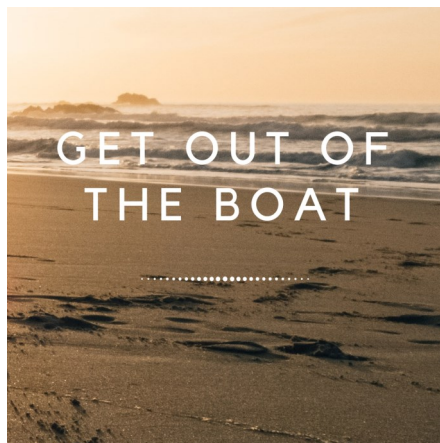

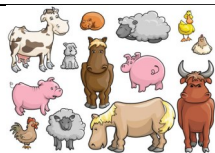
